- Java Webstart - Visit the [Collaborate First Time User](#) to run the Java software check

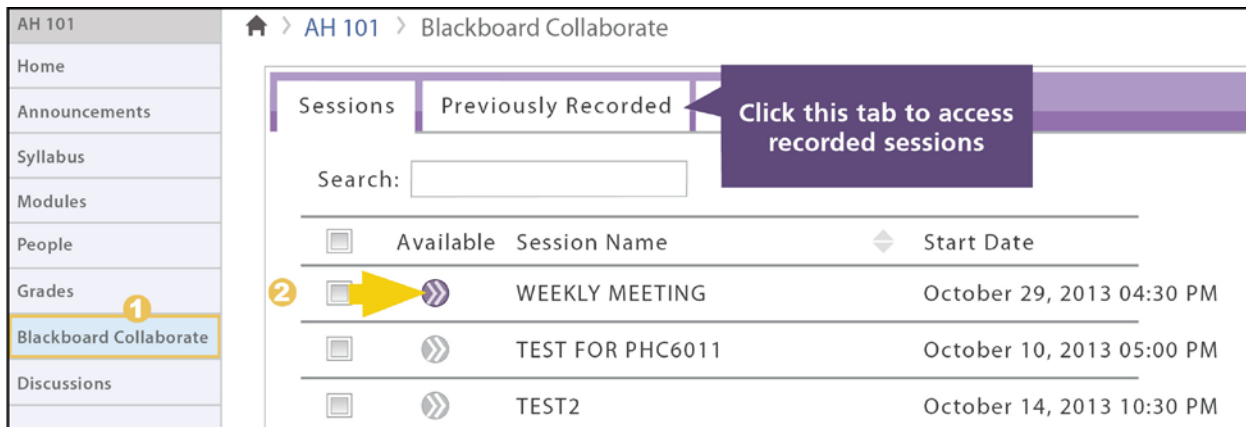
